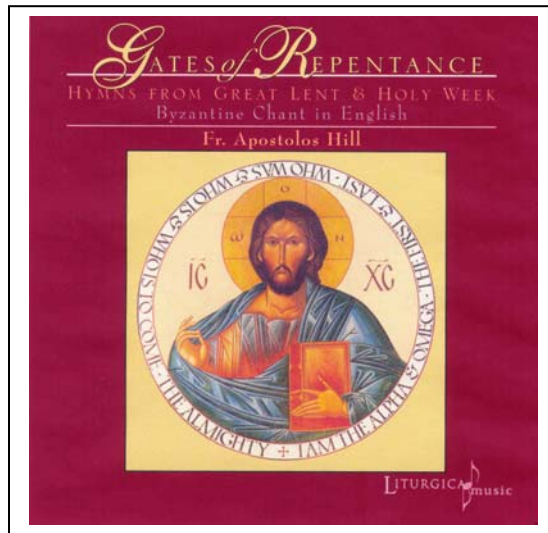

Fr. Apostolos Hill is Assistant Priest at Assumption Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Denver, CO. This hugely popular first recording of Byzantine chant in English has now been **re-engineered and re-released with eight new hymns and complete liner notes and hymn text.** It offers a wide range of the hymnology of Great Lent and Holy Week from the Eastern Orthodox liturgical tradition. The hymn selection follows the structure of the Lenten Triodion and begins with the Lenten Hymns from the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee and each of the Sundays of Great Lent. Holy Week selections include the Bridegroom Service, Holy Thursday Passion Gospel Service and the Vespers of Great Friday.
